An Aboriginal Redress Worker is happy to have a yarn about the National Redress Scheme.

The Scheme is a program which supports people who experienced **sexual abuse as a child**, in an institution* or in care.

The National Redress Scheme could also offer:

- A payment up to \$150,000
- Access to counselling
- A formal recognition of the abuse

*Institutions include: church groups, schools, boarding schools, missions, foster care, youth groups, sporting clubs, defence forces, charities, missions, juvenile detention and hospitals.
