- understand how power can be misused in the workplace and how perpetrators of violence use power and control,
- learn practical, trauma-informed ways to respond to disclosures of sexual violence and promote trust within teams and workplaces and,
- explore tools and approaches for venues, festivals, touring, events and music organisations of different sizes that promote gender equity in the workplace.

Whether you are strengthening existing systems or starting new conversations in your workplace, you will leave with practical strategies, shared language and greater confidence to lead respectfully and proactively.
